## GUIDELINES FOR MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR OUTDOOR FIREPLACES

### I. LOCATION.

The location of the fireplace shall be at least ten (10) feet from any over hanging branches, stumps, logs and trees.

### II. FIREPLACE SITE.

- A. The fireplace site shall consist of a circular area with a minimum radius of five (5) feet.
- B. The fireplace pad will consist of a circular area with a minimum radius of three (3) feet cleared to mineral soil and/or covered with gravel located in the center of the fireplace site. A concrete pad of the same dimensions may be used in lieu of mineral soil or gravel.
- C. The remaining two (2) feet of the five (5) foot radius circular fireplace site may contain vegetation as long as it is three(3) inches in height or less.
- D. If the campfire site is surrounded a road, the above B and C can be ignored.

### III. FIREPLACE CONSTRUCTION.

- A. The fireplace must consist of at least three (3) sides not less than ten (10) inches high.
- B. The fireplace must be constructed of non-combustible materials which are fastened or mortared together and in good condition.
- C. The fireplace shall be located on the fireplace pad and will be immobile. (Steel fireplaces must be staked down or somehow fastened to the pad).
